**Vaccines:** When your cat is boarding with us, for their own safety they must be current on **Rabies** and **FVRCP** vaccinations unless they have received a special dispensation from their veterinarian. If the vaccines were not received here, we require proof of vaccination be presented at drop off time. If your cat is a senior of 11 years of age or older, he or she must have proof an exam in the past 6 months. If elsewhere, please let us know in advance so we can request the records, or simply bring them with you. We can do their exam at check in if necessary. Additionally, we can update any expired vaccines at time of check in.
